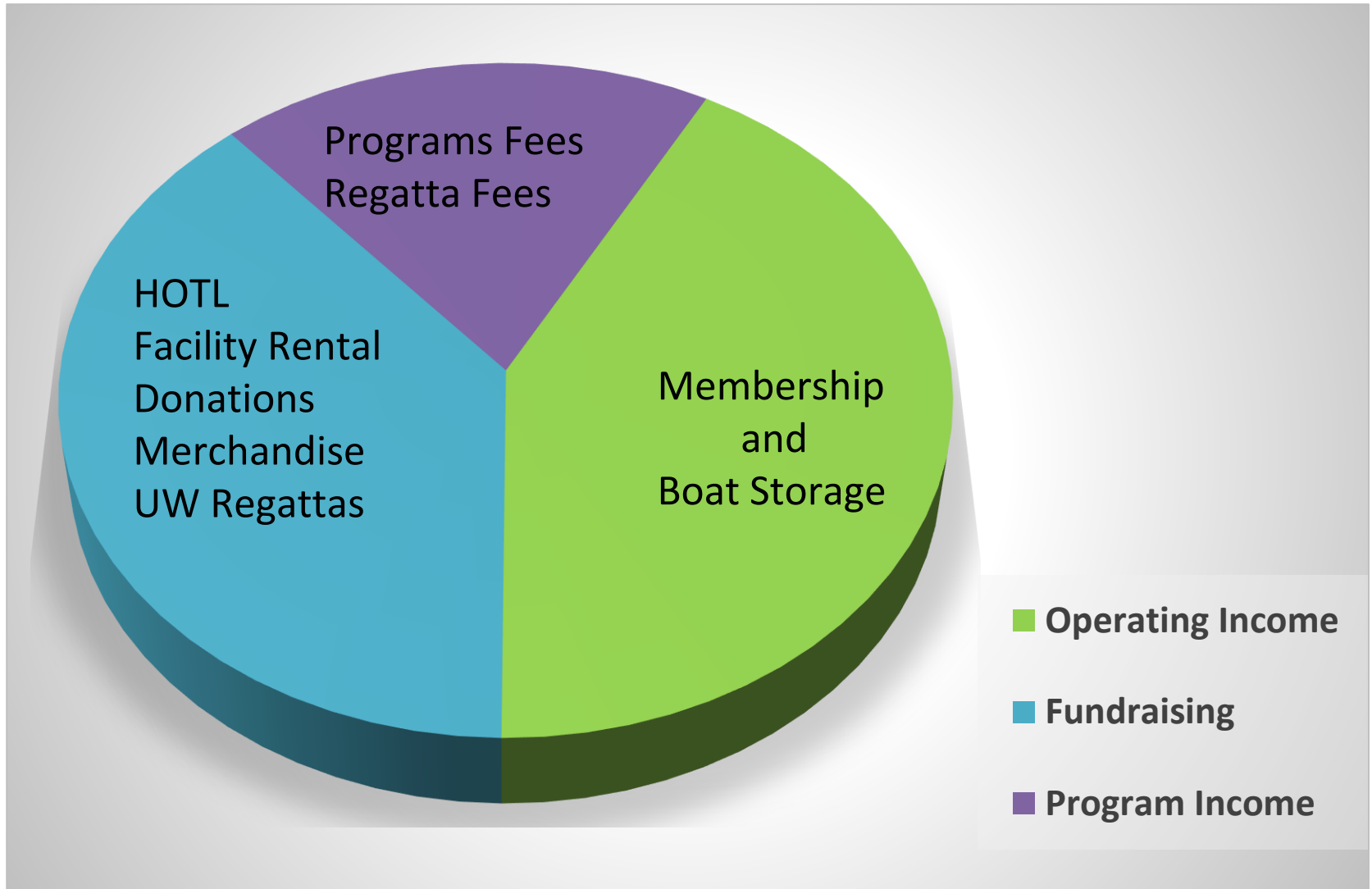

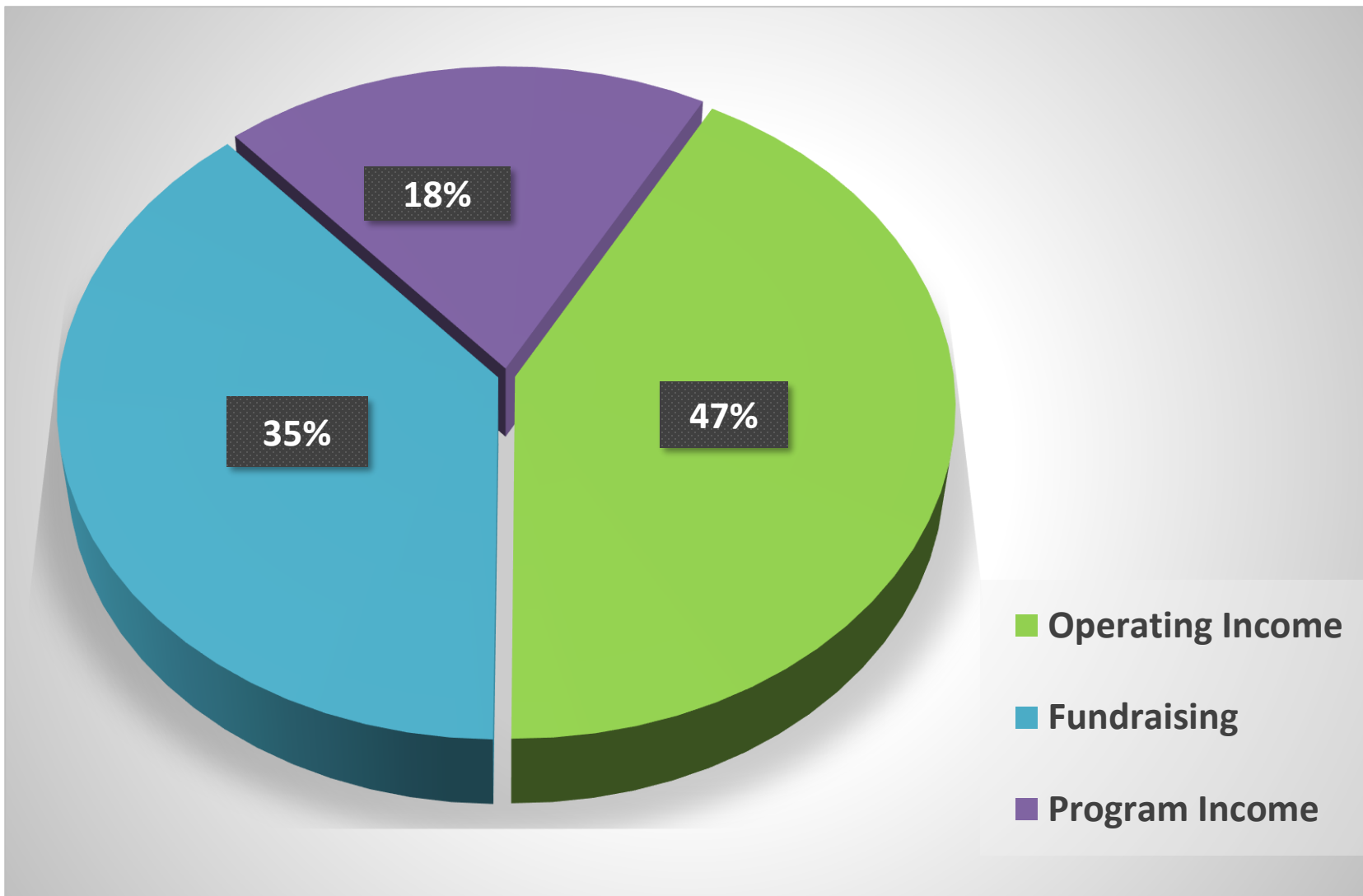
## 2018 Year in Review
